### LOT 586

A gold and silver set, diamond, sapphire and blue gem set three stone ring, mounted with the cushion cut diamond to the centre, ring size approx V (shank distorted).

Estimate: £150 - £200

### Condition Report

586. The ring is rather dirty and heavily tarnished. The central diamond is of irregular shape and the edge is chipped in places, this is probably as a result of being in a previous mount. There is slight variation of colour saturation to a sapphire, the other blue stone is slightly darker and is thought to be possibly synthetic. There is slight surface wear to the table facet edges of the blue stones. The blue gems may have been treated to enhance colour and clarity. We do not feel we can guarantee what the blue gems are, this is simply an expression of an opinion as we have no certificate to accompany the ring. The ring is quite crudely made, it is possibly of Indian or Ceylonese manufacture. Suggested age – 1920 to 1950, rather than being modern. The shank of the ring is distorted. The claws are generally a bit worn. The claws do not look to be have been interfered with, however the gemstones do not look well set, this could be a result of the distortion of the ring in the past. There is slight movement to the diamond in its setting. The under bezel of the ring is in good condition. There are no marks to the ring, which looks to be silver gilt. Personal viewing recommended. Weight 3.1g.

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
