A gold, rose cut diamond and sapphire two stone ring in a crossover design, ring size approx S1/2.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

587. The ring is showing signs of wear, it is heavily tarnished and is thought to be silver gilt, possibly of Ceylonese manufacture. The rose cut diamond slightly draws colour, the edge is badly chipped at one point. The sapphire has some evidence of colour zoning, although this is difficult to see as the ring is very dirty. The sapphire may possibly have been treated to enhance colour and clarity. The sapphire has one or two surface nicks to the facet edges. There are no marks to the ring, which has not been tested by us. Size of top of ring – 1.1cm. Suggested age – 1920 to 1950. Weight 2.9g.

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
