A gold, sapphire and diamond oval hinged bangle, circa 1910, mounted with a row of nine graduated oval and cushion cut sapphires alternating with eight diamond set two stone divisions, mounted with variously cut diamonds, on a snap clasp, inside width 6cm, fitted with a safety chain, with a case (two diamonds lacking).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

645. The sapphires are of medium colour saturation, some sapphires are showing colour saturation zoning. The sapphires are offered as natural. The diamonds are rather crude rose cut stones, with internal inclusions. Some inclusions reach the surfaces of the stones. The sapphire at one end looks to be replaced. There is a repair join at the centre of the back of the bangle which shows slight distortion. There are no marks to the piece. It is thought to be approx. 9ct gold, we have not tested the bangle ourselves. Gross weight of bangle – 11 grams. Principal sapphire approx. – 6mm x 5mm. One of the smaller sapphires approx. - 4mm x 3mm. Case - The case hinge is broken, the velvet is otherwise is good condition. The original retailers address printed in gilt within. Front catch and button remain intact. Weight 11g.

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
