### LOT 700

A white gold, sapphire and diamond bracelet, the front mounted with a row of nine graduated cushion cut sapphires and pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, on a sprung curved bar link bracelet, detailed '18ct', with a snap clasp, length 17.5cm.

### Condition Report

700. The sapphires are of medium to dark colour saturation. There is some variation of cut to the sapphires. The sapphires generally have some wear to the table facet edges. The sapphires are offered as natural, though it is possible that the sapphires have been treated to enhance colour and clarity in the past. The rose cut diamonds are generally clear stones. There is some variation of cut and one or two diamonds have surface reaching inclusions. The bangle is marked 'Britannic'. It is possible that the piece was originally yellow gold and has subsequently been plated over to give a white gold appearance. Suggested age – 1920s/30s. Weight 16.3g.
