## LOT 2020

A George I walnut secrétaire cabinet, in the manner of William Old and John Ody, the cavetto moulded pediment above a pair of bevelled mirror doors enclosing three later fitted shelves, the secrétaire drawer above four further drawers, all with feather banded borders, raised on bracket feet, height 189.3cm, width 111cm, depth 50cm (some alterations and restoration).

## Condition Report

2020. While the piece has a good overall appearance it has undergone a level of overall restoration at some point within the last 20 years, having been re-polished and restored for retail purposes. In terms of alterations, the interior of the top is clearly later and the mirror panels while old and good quality also appear to be later. The interior of the secrétaire has been very cleaned back and has a later leather inset. The handles are later having had central fitted handles at some stage. The feet have been reconstructed and it appears that the moulded edge around the base is also later.
