A William IV mahogany extending dining table, in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, the pull-out extending top with drop-flaps to both ends and two extra leaves, all carved with a gadrooned and acanthus leaf edge, raised on turned and tulip cusp legs terminating in brass caps and castors, height 72cm, fully extended length 239cm, depth 111cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2012. General overall condition and appearance is good. A good even colour to the top with only some minor scuffs and marks. The legs have been re-polished and the frieze has had some level of restoration to tidy up edges. The brass castors are good, but later replacements. Otherwise a good clean table.
