### LOT 1671

A Paris porcelain cup and saucer, early 19th century, the flared gilt ground cup painted with a topographical view within a palmette border, the high scroll handle with horse head terminal, unmarked, diameter of saucer 14.2cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

The cup and saucer are possibly matched. Both are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding to the saucer is a little worn, primarily to the centre. The gilding on the cup has some minor spots of wear but is generally in good order with overall light surface scratches. The lower handle terminal of the cup has a minor blemish/chip.
