A Berlin two-handled chocolate cup and trembleuse saucer, 19th century, painted with opposing figural landscape panels against a gilt ground beneath basketweave moulded detail, the saucer underside rim turquoise glazed, underglaze blue sceptre mark and gilt painted '15', diameter of saucer 14cm (damage to trembleuse piercing).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

The dark areas shown on the images on our website on the gilt ground are shadows.

The cup is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are some minor surface scratches/spots of wear to the gilt ground.

Saucer - small section of pierced raised gallery missing, otherwise there are some minor surface scratches to the gilt ground which has some minor wear to the rim edge.
