A Venini, Murano, Pezzato glass vase, originally designed circa 1955 by Fulvio Bianconi, the gently abstract flared cylindrical body with green and blue fused glass tesserae, engraved mark to base 'Venini Italia', height 20cm (surface scratches).

Condition Report

We have not seen enough of these Murano pieces to advise whether it is a period piece or a later issue. We have spoken to the vendor who apparently purchased it fairly recently at a car boot sale. Please see the extra images on our website using the zoom function where there is a close up of the engraved mark. There is a good amount of typical wear/scratches to the footrim.

The body overall has a lot of very deep noticeable and often concentrated scratches, particularly to one side and in a patch to the other side - but also, I repeat, to the body overall, including the rim.

There does not appear to have been any re-polishing of damage or any repairs.

There are some light and minor surface scratches to the interior.
