A pair of Continental white and pale blue overlaid glass vases, late 19th century, each of tapered form cut with elongated oval panels edged in gilt against a dotted ground, raised on three gilt ball feet, height 15cm, together with a French opaque glass vase, enamelled with birds, height 24cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Pair - One of the vases has an approximate 2cm long internal crack beneath one of the feet - only noticeable when a strong light is shone from behind it and it can be seen to the base interior of the vase - otherwise both of the vases are in good order with minor rubbing to the gilding on the typical high and touch points.

Vase with birds - in good condition overall with some minor and light surface scratches. Gilding rubbed.
