An Hispano Moresque (Narbonne) maiolica albarelo, probably 17th century, of waisted cylindrical form, painted in pale lustre against a cream ground with an inscribed shield surrounded by scrolling tendrils, opposing two geometric panels of stylized leaves, height 28cm (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of the late Professor Maurice Stacey.

## Condition Report

The albarelo has some typical fritting and chipping to the rims and some areas of fritting to the body. Some of the chips around the footrim appear to have some minor later filling with a cement like material, but structurally the albarelo is sound with no cracks or major restoration.
