A gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with a row of cushion cut diamonds graduating in size to the centre stone, weight 3.5g, ring size approx J1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

The mount with typical surface scratches and wear but otherwise the shank and setting is in good order. The diamonds are fairly white stones but all five are fairly heavily marked with numerous speck inclusions to all, probably averaging between SI to I clarity. The principal stone has a few minor chips to its girdle and is approx 1ct. The outer diamonds are approx 0.3ct and 0.15ct. One of the diamonds next to the main stone has a small chip to its table facet edge, the smaller stone next to this has a chip to the side edge beneath the outer claw. The smallest stone at the other end has a small chip to the girdle. Approximate total diamond weight 2ct. It would benefit from a professional clean. Central stone approximately 5mm x 5mm.
