A gold, foil backed amethyst and half-pearl oval brooch, as converted from a clasp, weight 6g, width 2.1cm, a gold brooch, mounted with an oval cut citrine, weight 2.3g, width 1.6cm, and a colourless paste brooch, designed as a racehorse and jockey, width 3cm.

Condition Report

516. Amethyst - of medium to pale colour saturation, backing foil in good condition, pearls have attractive silvery lustre, later brooch fittings are base metal with evidence of previous fitting adaptation in the form of two tubes.

Citrine - one or two tiny surface marks, but is generally in good condition.

Horse - some colourless pastes lacking, there is an overall general discolouration to the pastes, jockey at one time was painted, this is now largely lacking, legs of horse a bit bent.
