A graduated pair of Chinese blue and white export porcelain meat dishes, Qianlong period, each painted with a pair of fallow deer in a lakeside scene with pine and bamboo beside and pavilion beyond, lengths 34.5cm and 31cm (minor rim chips to smaller dish).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Large dish - in good condition, no cracks or restoration. There is a teeny tiny flake chip to the rim, of no real significance. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Smaller dish - again in generally good condition with a couple of small chips to the rim, but no cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.
