A collection of Chinese porcelain animals and birds, 20th century, including a figure of a phoenix, height 31cm, a pair of sancai glazed Buddhist lions, height 9cm, turquoise glazed Buddhist lions and a pair of cats (some faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Phoenix - broken beak which has been chipped and re-glued with some losses, both upper sections of wings have been broken and re-glued, there is also a crack to the neck.

Pair large parrots - one has a hairline crack to its neck, otherwise both in good condition, quite dirty.

Small turquoise glazed seated buddhistic lion - has been broken across the neck and re-glued.

All of the other animals appear to be in good condition with no significant damage or repairs.
