

LOT 516

A gold and diamond single stone ring, mounted with a cushion cut diamond, a 9ct gold, ruby and diamond seven stone cluster ring, a 9ct gold and colourless gem set ring and two further gem set rings.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

516. Single stone diamond ring – stamped '18' at the back of the front of the ring near the edge of the diamond and this suggests 18ct gold. The old cut diamond looks to be a fairly clear stone apart from a black piqué inclusion, claws to diamond are a bit rubbed, engraved decoration to the shoulders a bit rubbed. Weight of diamond approx – 0.07ct. ring size approx I1/2. Gross weight of ring 1.1grams. Ring is currently rather dirty and would benefit from professional cleaning.

9ct gold ruby and diamond ring – ruby is of medium to pale colour saturation, diamonds have a few internal inclusions, 9ct gold hallmark is partly worn, ring a bit worn as a result of contact with other rings, ring size approx K, gross weight 0.9grams.

9ct gold and colourless gem ring – shank is stamped 'CZ', claws good condition, ring would benefit from cleaning, ring size approx P1/2, gross weight 2.6grams.

Fourth ring – Continental silver and colourless paste, the centre paste is rather worn and the paste shoulders are not open at the back, generally rather dirty, foreign silver marks to outside of band, ring size approx J.

Fifth ring – citrine and marcasite, the citrine has one or two tiny surface marks to the table facet edge, one marcasite missing to one shoulder, unmarked but likely to be silver, ring size approx L.

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
