Condition Report

1106. The timepiece cosmetically looks in fairly good decorative condition.

The dial has been repainted. There is a split to the mahogany surround at 9 o'clock and smaller repaired splits at 2 and 3 o'clock. The case box has had some restoration and is missing two of its pegs.

When looking at the movement, you can see some cut out adjustments to the mahogany to fit the false plate and movement in place. This would suggest that the timepiece did not all start life together. All of this can be seen in the images on our website.

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
