An early 19th century mahogany circular wall timepiece with brass eight day single fusee movement, the repainted 12-inch convex dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'S.B. Gaze London', within a moulded circular surround with cast brass bezel and convex glass, the case box with hinged doors to side and underside, diameter 35.5cm, with pendulum. Note: Samuel Bartholomew Gaze is recorded in 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' by Brian Loomes as working in London between 1817 and 1857.

Condition Report

1101. Generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs. Re-painted dial. The movement winds smoothly and runs, but only for about 5-6 minutes before stopping. Case in generally good order with typical minor wear and a few small nicks, dents to surround.

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
