A late 19th century French opaline glass and gilded bronze table oil lamp, the glass lift-out reservoir and flared body decorated with stylized plants, the stand finely cast with masks and scrolls, height 44cm, together with a frosted pink glass shade.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

2564. The shade has a few very small nibbles to its lower edge. The glass of the main body and reservoir are both in good order, with only some small surface chips to the underside where it sits on the metal base. The base is slightly misshapen and does tend to wobble slightly on a flat surface. The base and metal mounts have overall surface wear and some oxidization. The 'Messenger' burner has a chipped swivel button and the brass lugs on the rim of the reservoir are both missing, so the burner is not held in place properly. The lamp has not been drilled for conversion.
