Condition Report

1015. One vase in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The other vase has a minor 2cm long vertical haircrack to the upright neck and an associated 1cm wide unsprung chip to the rim around this haircrack - please see the detailed images on our website - otherwise in good condition with no cracks or restoration.

The enamels and gilding on both vases are strong and bright. The matching cover is in good condition with a very minor nick to the base end and wear to the gilding of the finial. The cover that is matched to the vases has a glued repair to the head and neck of the lion finial and is missing the back end of the lion.
