A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, mark of Kangxi but probably 20th century, the high-shouldered baluster body beneath a slender neck and onion mouth, painted with taotie and lappet panels with ruyi head and dotted borders, underglaze blue pain

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

1024. In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is overall indistinct pitting to the glaze, a manufacturing issue, and some minor brown rust spots. There is a minor and indistinct glazed over approx 1cm long vertical firing crack to the neck rim interior. There are typical light surface scratches, primarily to the widest part of the body.
