### Condition Report

1069. Teapot - In good condition overall. There is a fritted chip to the side edge of the handle and a minuscule unsprung nick to the tip of the spout. The gilding on the handle terminals and spout is worn. The cover has a small chip to the inner flange and a minuscule glaze nick to the edge.

Bowl - There is an approx 9cm long angled vertical haircrack to the bowl rim as well as a 2cm long by 0.5cm wide chip to the rim edge exterior and an approx 1cm long narrow glaze frit/chip to the rim edge. Typical light wear to bowl interior.
