A Chinese blue and white enameled porcelain bottle vase, mid to late 19th century, enamelled with white lotus, peonies, prunus and chrysanthemums on a blue ground, height 30.5cm (repaired neck), together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1154. Vase - Approx 7cm long by 3.5cm deep (at widest point) part of neck rim broken away in 3 pieces and visibly glued, with some losses along the break lines and an unsprung chip to rim interior alongside. There is a drill hole just above the footrim. Some very minor surface scratches.

Centrepiece stand - Some very minor fritted chipping to neck rim interior, both figures missing lower section of one arm, in addition one with minor chip to one foot. One of the relief flowers on the stem has a chipped petal.
