Condition Report

1249. Large vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some minor and light surface scratches. Gilding to rim worn.

Square vase with green neck - 1.5cm by 0.6cm flat chip to underside edge of body above foot, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Square vase with blue neck - minuscule glaze nick to shoulder of vase, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Light wear to enamels.
