An Art Deco Lalique opalescent glass Perruches pattern bowl, circa 1931, the exterior moulded with a continuous band of budgerigars amongst foliage against a blue stained ground, acid etched 'R. Lalique France' to base, diameter 23.7cm (minor fault).

Condition Report

1735. One bird head to the exterior has a small glued repair - please see the extra images on our website using the zoom function. The top rim edge of the bowl has typical teeny tiny nicks to the circumference - only visible on very close inspection. Otherwise the bowl interior is quite heavily scratched to the surface, with similar surface scratches to a lesser extent to the exterior.
