Condition Report

424. Both compacts in good condition. Hinges are good. One engraved with crest, the other initialled and dated to base.

Shell dish - good condition, typical light wear.

All other pieces in generally good condition with typical light wear. The dumbbell rattle has a few dents. The rectangular pillbox has a dent and misshapen rim and slight misshaping to the thimble rims.
