A pair of William IV silver wine coasters, each with reeded rim above pierced and engraved sides above turned mahogany base, London 1830 (maker's mark rubbed), diameter 12.2cm.

Condition Report

454. Generally in fairly good condition. One has a pierced upright missing to the pierced band and another upright appears to have been repaired. The other also looks like it has had a small section of repair to the pierced band. Both small cartouches have had an erasure. Typical wear and minor dents to silver and slight misshaping to rims. Marks are typically tricky to read and maker's mark is not readable. Wood bases intact but worn and in need of polish.
