A Minton majolica jardinière, circa 1869, of oval shape with turquoise glazed exterior, the cherub form handles supporting foliate swags meeting at mask centred shields to each side, raised on an oval foot, pink glazed interior, impressed marks to base, shape No. 1400, length 44cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

Typical overall fine crazing to glaze. 2.5cm long by 1.5cm wide chip to top rim edge by one handle and 4cm long vertical haircrack to rim by one mask. Small chip to rim edge of both shells which the putto handles stand on, and in addition a small chip to the side edge of one of the ochre scrolls behind these shells.

No restoration.
