A Meissen porcelain figural comport and stand, late 19th century, surmounted by a pierced two-handled basket, painted and encrusted with flowers, raised on a similarly adorned trunk stem flanked by two putti, the matching stand of square shape, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases with incised shape No. D.196 to comport and stand, overall height 39cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

Overall the comport and stand are in very good condition with no restoration or cracks.

Considering the intricate detail of the applied flowers and foliage there are only minor losses and chips.

One putto has a lute which is missing the top end of the handle, the other putto has a pipe which is missing the top end.

The stand has typical and expected spots of wear to its upper surface where the comport sits on it.
