A Moorcroft Pansy pattern vase, mid-20th century, of tapered high-shouldered form with blue glazed ground, impressed marks to base with facsimile signature and blue painted initials, height 15.5cm, together with a Freesia pattern rectangular box and cover, 12cm x 9cm (minor glaze faults).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

1524. Vase - a flat glaze chip, approx 1cm in length, to footrim, probably from manufacture. A few manufacturing glaze blemishes to footrim and one to shoulder of body. Otherwise in good condition, with overall crazing.

Box and cover - overall crazing. A few minor glaze chips to corners of box. Otherwise in generally good condition.
