### LOT 1548

Two Cope & Co Art Deco wall masks, modelled as the heads of ladies wearing hats, one with impressed factory mark, together with a Continental pottery figure of a girl holding her hat on against the wind, height 25cm, and a Wade figure Conchita (repaired).

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

Wall masks - both crazed but otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Wade figure - typical crazing to glaze with minor losses/fritting along edges of skirt hems, missing left thumb, left leg glued where joins to underside of skirt with some losses to the glaze around the join, the left shoe with glued heel and chipped toe.

Other figure - crazing to glaze, left fingers chipped away, two small inconsequential chips to footrim, minor manufacturer's glaze fault to hem of skirt.
