A Regency coromandel and brass bound vanity box by Lambe & Wells, Cockspur Street, the hinged lid inset with an initialled plaque, the leather-lined interior fitted with glass jars with plated and silver tops, height 11cm, width 31.5cm.

Condition Report

2630. Generally good order with a repaired stud to brass banding on front, as well as a few dents to rear edge. There is also a very thin surface crack to veneer on front.

There is fairly typical slight wear to the interior, with surface wear to lids, scratching to glass jars and a few small chips to the corners of one long rectangular glass box. Two of the circular jars have silver lids and one is plated. The rest of the tops are also plated. Some slight damage to fabric on inside of lid.
