Two Derby figures of putti, circa 1770, both wearing floral garlands and holding a bird's nest, height 14cm (one badly repaired), together with two other Derby figures of a gallant with a lamb and a shepherdess, height 19cm, and a pair of Volkstedt figures (faults and repairs).

Condition Report

Two Derby Putti - one in good condition overall with typical chips/losses to applied flowers and foliage, glued repair to left thumb with associated small chip and losses to 2 wings of birds in nest. The other badly damaged and visibly repaired.

Derby Gallant - narrow 2cm long chip to front edge of base, missing left hand, minor nick to hat brim and edge of waistcoat, typical chips/losses to applied flowers and foliage.

Derby Shepherdess - badly glued repair to neck, tiny nick to edge of base, minor nicks to brim of hat, typical chips/losses to flowers and foliage.

Volkstedt man - missing cane, 3 fingers and 1 thumb.

Volkstedt woman - glued repair to neck, missing 2 fingers.
