A Worcester blue printed jug, circa 1770, decorated with the Natural Sprays Group over a leaf moulded body, with mask spout, underglaze blue mark to base, height 20cm (minor chipping to spout), together with a Mansfield pattern teabowl and saucer, diameter of saucer 12cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Jug - approx 1cm square flat chip to outer edge of foot almost beneath spout, some minor chipping to spout, some surface scratches to glaze on widest part of body.

Teabowl - minor chip to inner rim edge of footrim, otherwise ok.

Saucer - surface scratches/wear to well, otherwise ok.
