A pair of Worcester porcelain sparrow beak jugs and covers and an ovoid tea jar, circa 1770, each printed in blue with the Three Flowers pattern, hatched crescent marks in underglaze blue to bases, height of jar 12.5cm (minor faults), together with a Rock Strata Island pattern saucer.

### Condition Report

Jug covers - one with small chip to edge, both with chipped petals to finials.

First jug - crack to upper handle terminal, surface scratches to widest part of body.

Second jug - small chip to spout outer edge, surface scratches to widest part of body.

Jar - no cover, surface scratches to widest part of body, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Saucer - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical light surface scratches.
