A Rudolstadt Volkstedt two-handled vase and cover, late 19th century, the lobed bulbous body painted with panels of fruit against a gilt overlaid pale lemon and cobalt blue ground, height 22cm, together with a miniature Worcester mug, circa 1903, two Worcester flat back jugs, height 9.5cm and 10.5cm, and a Staffordshire potpourri vase and cover, height 16cm (minor faults and restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Rudolstadt - small chip to inner base edge of cover, indistinct gilt painted over chip to top of foot, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light rubbing to gilding in expected places.

Miniature mug - visible haircrack to footrim, otherwise ok.

Flatback jugs - both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Potpourri - some crazing to glaze, approx 3cm long by 1cm wide section of rim broken away and visibly repaired with some minor losses along the break line and associated short hairline, with another approx 1.5cm long stained haircrack to the rim almost opposite.
