LOT 1140

A late 19th century French rosewood mantel clock, the eight day movement with silk suspension, striking hours and half hours on a bell via an outside countwheel, the silvered circular dial with Roman hour numerals, the rectangular case with line inlaid decoration, on a plinth base and turned feet, height 33.5cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1140. The clock is in generally good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Dial a little worn, but otherwise good.

Two small circular veneer infills to top of case where originally it would have had a brass carry handle. Glass door at front gapes open slightly.

Movement winds smoothly and appears to be in good order but silk suspension is broken so cannot tell if it runs.

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
