The glass eyes have a couple of minor surface scratches visible under magnification. The thread is good and the cover screws down tightly. Glass in good order with no significant damage or repairs.

Blue glass bottle - in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Some typical wear to gilt speckling. Silver screw cover in good order with good clear marks, screws down nice and tightly, typical light surface scratches.
