Condition Report

2554. Two of the larger bottles have small chips to edges of rim, but otherwise appear to be ok. The interior of the drawer has a set of balance scales and weights in top tray and has a mixing bowl, glass measure and two further bottles, all of which are ok. There is some powder spillage and general wear to the interior. Uneven surface polish to exterior.
