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A Chinese silk embroidered oval panel, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured threads with a pair of peacocks perched on rocks beneath a blossoming branch, various other birds and butterflies, within a hardwood rectangular frame with carved and pierced lotus and scrolling tendril border, height of panel 24cm, dimensions of frame 35cm x 27.5cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1035. The silk panel appears to be in generally good condition. As can be seen in the online images, the quality and colours are good and vibrant, and there is a small darker stained area at the bottom of the panel. There are also a few other minor stain spots, but nothing of any real significance.

Frame has some small areas of loss and chips to some of the pierced work, particularly to the lower left corner.

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
