A Chinese crackle glazed porcelain double gourd shaped vase, late Qing dynasty, the upper and lower bulb decorated with an iron oxide washed band with prunus flowerheads at intervals, height 41.5cm.

Condition Report

1053. The vase is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Very small chip to footrim, but no apparent cracks or restoration. However, the vase has a plaster filled neck where it has been used as a table lamp. We think this is probably fairly easily removed.
