### LOT 1304

A Japanese Arita blue and white porcelain circular dish, Meiji period, painted with landscape panels and foliage, diameter 40.5cm, together with a Japanese cloisonné circular dish, diameter 24.5cm, two Chinese blue and white ginger jars and covers and two Canton famille rose cylindrical boxes and covers (some faults).

### Condition Report

1304. Japanese blue and white dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Blue and white jar and cover - jar in good condition, cover broken into numerous pieces and re-glued.

Smaller blue and white jar - jar in good condition, cover broken in half and re-glued.

Canton figural box and cover - cover broken in half, re-glued and chips to rim. Base is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Canton floral box and cover - cover with minor rim chips, box broken in two, re-glued and rim chips.

Japanese cloisonne dish - slightly misshapen, some faint hairlines and minor pitting, but no significant damage or repairs. Underside with one small section (scale) of loss to turquoise enamel.
