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A late 19th/early 20th century Louis Vuitton travelling trunk with overall monogram and quatrefoil decorated canvas covering, the corners and edges with applied metal mounts, the lid and sides with studded wooden straps, the linen-lined interior fitted with a removable tray, bearing label detailed 'Louis Vuitton, Paris 70 Champs Elysees...' and numbered '777411', the base fitted with barrel castors, height 35cm, width 102cm, depth 54cm (some faults, lacking side handles).

Condition Report

2666. Please refer to photos for good idea of condition from all angles. Overall surface wear, scuffs and marks. Strap holders damaged on both sides. Splits to canvas along hinged seam. Dents to edges of clasp, where it has been forced open, and replaced screws to the corners of front lock plate, which has been attached to an added piece of wood to interior.

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
