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A 9ct gold mounted circular pendant locket, Birmingham 1908, length 3.9cm, a gold shaped oval pendant locket, glazed with the photograph of a sailor, detailed '9c', weight 6.3g, length 4cm, with a gilt metal neckchain, two further pendant lockets, a colourless paste brooch, designed as a fawn, two silver brooches and a cameo brooch.

Condition Report

722. Gold mounted locket I top slightly distorted.

Shaped oval locket I suspension loop has been reapplied, chips to interior of border of glass, small tear to photographic image, front border good condition, original suspension missing, one or two dents to the back. Circular locket I dents to engine turned back and front, wear to the top of the suspension loop, the hinges are rather weak, a few dents to the edge.

Circular locket with floral engraved decoration I good condition but suspension to hold chain is missing. Silver brooch with hearts I engraved 'N' to one heart and 'M' to the other.

Horseshoe brooch I riding crop broken off at both ends and hinge to pin has been reapplied. Bambi brooch I good condition, no marks.

Cameo brooch I is moulded paste, chip to edge of front of portrait. The setting is base metal.

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
