A diamond brooch, designed as a swallow in flight, mounted with rose cut diamonds with a ruby set eye, unmarked, weight 6.5g, width 4.7cm (two diamonds lacking).

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

762. The wing tips are slightly distorted and require straightening. The hinge to the pin and the hook are also distorted and require straightening. The setting is silver fronted with a gilt finish to the back. The ruby eye is a bit chipped and worn. Please note that two of the rose cut diamonds are missing. The rose cut diamonds have a few internal inclusions, some of which are surface reaching. There is variation of cut and depth to the rose cut diamonds. It is not possible to provide an approximate carat weight of the diamonds. Suggested age late quarter of the 19th century.
