Condition Report

329. Christening cup - generally good condition, but there has been a small lead repair at both handle joints. Foot is slightly bent/uneven so would need attention. Engraved initials to front. Otherwise decoration is quite good with only typical light wear and hallmarks are good.

Cylindrical box and cover - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface wear and scratches. Good clear marks.

Watering can - small lead repairs to handle joints and spout joints. Few dents to base and typical wear to highpoints. Good clear hallmarks.
