A Derby Fury Group, circa 1780, modelled as an angry lady leaning over a man who has fallen on the floor on a broken chair, raised on a naturalistic base, indistinct incised marks to base, height 14cm (restored). Note: a similar figure group is illustrated by John Twitchett in 'Derby Porcelain 1748-1848', p. 145, colour plate 98.

Condition Report

1415. The lady's right arm is completely restored from shoulder down and is also missing its thumb. The overpainting has yellowed. There is a small hairline crack from her neck and down left shoulder. The rest of her and the chair are in good order. The tree stump behind has chipped leaves and restored tip. The man is in generally good order except his right foot which has been broken and re-glued and the stool below him has a chip to end of one leg. The base is in good condition with only minor paint loss and minor chips to leaves.
