An 18ct gold, blue and green enamelled and diamond set ring in a foliate design, claw set with four circular cut diamonds, otherwise with green and blue enamelled foliate decoration, London 1991, weight 7.6g, ring size approx I1/2.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

634. One of the blue enamelled petals is chipped. The diamonds slightly draw colour and have one or two internal inclusions. The claws are in good condition. When viewed from the back lead solder has been used in several places. It is possible that this ring has been reconstructed from a single earring with the use of lead solder. The hallmark relates to the shank rather than the associated top.
