An 18ct gold ring, claw set with a row of five graduated cushion cut diamonds, Birmingham 1986, weight 2.5g, ring size approx N, with a case.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

621. Central diamond has slight yellow tint. Under magnification the quality of the facet edges is lacking slightly, particularly around the table facet. Also has an internal inclusion under the table facet. Size approx 5mmx 4mm.

Side diamonds have a few internal inclusions. Three or four claws have worn away and will need re-tipping. The ring has a portion of the mount missing directly below the central stone. A few tiny dents and scratches to shank.
