A pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain moonflasks, late 19th century, each of flattened circular form, one side painted with a band of soldiers, the other with a pair of pheasants on rocks amidst peony and magnolia, within pink glazed borders filled with polychrome peaches, lotus and scrolling tendrils, applied with a pair of gilt dragon moulded handles, unmarked, height 24.9cm.

1160. Both in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Each has restoration to the tail of one gilt dragon handle. Otherwise enamels are good and vibrant. Typical wear to gilt on rims.
